



#### **VISIT TO CORCOVADO**

Duration: 4 hours



Corcovado is a granite peak 710 meters high, located in the Tijuca Forest, offering a privileged view of the city of Rio de Janeiro and Guanabara Bay. It is famous for hosting at its summit the Christ the Redeemer statue, one of the main symbols of the city and the country. The Corcovado railway line, starting from the Cosme Velho station, was inaugurated in 1884. Stretching 3,824 meters, it was the first in the country to be built exclusively for tourism purposes.

The train, older than the statue itself, transported the materials needed for its construction during the four years of work. In 1910, this line became the first in Brazil to be electrified, and the old steam trains were replaced by electric engines.



#### **ASCENT OF SUGARLOAF MOUNTAIN**

Duration: 4 hours



The ascent of Sugarloaf Mountain is done via a cable car in two stages: the first ride will take you to the Urca Mountain, where you can already enjoy a stunning view of the city. On the second cable car ride, you will reach the summit of Sugarloaf Mountain. This name evokes blocks of refined sugar placed in clay molds for transportation by boat during the sugarcane trade era. However, it is possible that this explanation is merely popular etymology, and the name may actually derive from the Tupi-Guarani term *Pau-nh-acuqua* ("big hill" in Portuguese). This peak, a monolithic granite block, is the only one among the city's peaks to rise directly from the seashore. It is located on a peninsula at the entrance to Guanabara Bay.



### **BRAZILIAN COOKING CLASS**

Duration: 4 hours



Immerse yourself in one of the key aspects of Brazilian culture: cuisine! Take a cooking class in Rio de Janeiro and learn how to prepare the most delicious Brazilian dishes. Taste the flavors of Brazil and discover local culinary techniques. You will learn several traditional recipes that you can then enjoy!



#### SAMBA CLASS AT THE GRAND CARLINHOS DE JESUS SCHOOL

Considered the best and greatest Samba dancer, Carlinhos de Jesus is among Brazil's legends. Having traversed different eras and generations, Samba and the world of carnival hold no secrets for him. He has opened a school in the Botafogo neighborhood where his handpicked troupe offers Samba and percussion lessons.



## VISIT TO THE SOCCER TEMPLE, THE MARACANÃ

Duration: 4 hours

A temple of soccer, the stadium was built for the FIFA World Cup Brazil 1950 and is immortalized by one of the most significant moments in the history of the tournament, namely the unforgettable final between Brazil and Uruguay. For the 2014 FIFA World Cup, the Maracanã was renovated. Once known as "the largest stadium in the world," which sometimes hosted over 200,000 spectators, its capacity was reduced to 73,531 spectators.



ART TOUR IN RIO: A JOURNEY TO THE HEART OF CREATION

Duration: 6 hours



Discover art in all its forms with this 6-hour tour in Rio de Janeiro. Start with an immersive visit to Fábrica Bhering, a former industrial complex transformed into artists' studios. Then, dive into the vibrant world of street art with a guided tour of the city's most iconic graffiti. Finally, end your adventure at a contemporary art gallery in Ipanema, where you'll explore an exhibition showcasing Brazilian artists, with works from some of the greatest Brazilian and international artists waiting for you. An unforgettable artistic journey at the heart of Rio!



VISIT TO THE BOTONICAL GARDEN

Duration: 4 hours



Considered one of the best tropical botanical gardens in the world, this haven of peace houses rare specimens of Brazilian flora as well as plants from other countries. It is also a popular spot for many species of tropical birds. Established in 1808, it spans 137 hectares. The garden is divided into several sections (Japanese, sensory, tropical, cactus). Listen carefully! If you hear branches cracking, it means the monkeys are overhead.



**HIKING IN TIJUCA FOREST** 

Duration: 4 hours

Tijuca Forest is a reforested mountainous region located within the city of Rio de Janeiro. It is considered the largest urban forest in the world, covering an area of 32 km<sup>2</sup>.

Your French-speaking guide will pick you up at the hotel at 8:00 AM. Private transportation (approximately 30 minutes) will take you to Tijuca Forest. There will be stops at the viewpoints at Mesa do Imperador and Vista Chinesa, followed by a visit to the Taunay Waterfall. Entry to the park will be through the visitors' center, and then you will be transported to the start of the hike. The hike to Pico da Tijuca will take approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes round-trip (medium level).



VISIT OF THE SANTA TERESA NEIGHTBORHOOD

Duration: 4 hours



Santa Teresa, built around the convent of the same name in the 18th century, was once a residential area for the city's bourgeoisie and became one of Rio de Janeiro's earliest expansions. The neighborhood is known for its French-inspired architecture, some of which still stands today.

In 1872, the "bonde" (tramway) arrived, becoming a symbol of the area. Since 1896, this tramway has provided a scenic route to the city center, crossing the iconic Lapa Arches, a decommissioned aqueduct.



**EVENING AT RIO SCENARIUM** 

Duration: 5 hours

In the heart of Rio, Rio Scenarium is located in the vibrant Lapa neighborhood. Like an antique store, it enchants with its unique and singular originality. With multiple floors and different atmospheres, the musical ambiance is quite varied: samba, MPB (Brazilian Popular Music), bossa nova, and jazz. Rio Scenarium is one of the classics of Carioca nightlife!

Please note that this establishment is closed from Sunday to Tuesday.




#### **VISIT OF THE HISTORICAL CENTER**

Duration: 4 hours



The center of Rio de Janeiro, despite some residential buildings, is primarily a commercial and tourist area, housing the largest concentration of financial establishments. Historical buildings coexist with modern skyscrapers in this vibrant space. The area boasts numerous churches and a rich historical heritage that spans colonial, imperial, republican, and contemporary periods. Notable examples include the Capanema Building, a project by Le Corbusier, Oscar Niemeyer, and Lucio Costa, offering a true sense of traversing through time. *Note: This tour should be avoided on Sundays.* 



# VISIT TO THE BABILONIA-CHAPEU MANGUEIRA COMMUNITY



Duration: 4 hours

Located on the hillside in the Copacabana neighborhood, this favela was famously featured in the opening scenes of the film *Orfeu Negro* by Marcel Camus. With a small community of around 3,000 residents, the area offers a unique perspective on life in Rio's favelas.

During your visit, you will wander through the winding streets of the favela, where you'll have the chance to view Copacabana Beach, Sugarloaf Mountain, and the Christ the Redeemer statue from new and fascinating angles. The community was pacified in 2009, meaning it is no longer under the control of drug traffickers.

To reach the community, guests will use mototaxis, a common form of local transport (journey time: approximately 2 minutes).

**BUGGY RIDE TO TATAJUBA (WEST COAST)** 

Duration: 6 hours



Take an exciting ride through the dunes and be rewarded with a freshwater lagoon. Tatajuba and Lagoa Grande are located next to each other, sharing the same white sands and calm, blue waters. You will find a few beachfront restaurants offering delicious cuisine and a relaxing spot under a shaded palapa.

#### **BUGGY RIDE TO LAGOAS AZUL & PARAISO**

Duration : 6 hours

Let yourself be carried away by an exciting ride through the dunes and freshwater lagoons. Lagoa Azul and Paraíso are located next to each other, sharing the same white sands and tranquil blue waters. These are perfect spots to relax while taking in the natural beauty of the landscape. Barrinha is an ideal place to watch the sunset between the dunes and coconut palms.

#### **BOOKING CONDITIONS**

To confirm Brazil Sensations' services, the following information is required:

- Full names of travelers as per their passports
- Date of birth
- Passport number with which the traveler will enter Brazil and its expiry date
- Nationality
- Exact details of international flights (numbers, times, and airline) and eticket number (this information can be provided later), as well as domestic flights if necessary.

Brazil Sensations will make all necessary initial bookings based on the jointly agreed services and will send a confirmation card (OK = confirmed; WL = waitlist; RQ = awaiting response).

- Upon confirmation of the booking, an advance invoice will be sent according to the requirements of certain suppliers to guarantee the reservation of the booked land services (approximately 20% for these dates).
- The final invoice must be paid 30 days before the passengers' arrival. If the invoice amount is not settled in full before the passengers' arrival, we reserve the right not to provide the corresponding services, in proportion to the unpaid amount or to modify the services provided compared to the originally planned program. In such cases, we will not be held responsible and will not entertain any claims or compensation.

#### **CANCELLATION**

Any cancellation must be communicated in writing and in accordance with the conditions below:

#### LAND SERVICES

- €50/pax penalty if cancellation is made more than 30 days before the passengers' arrival
- 20% penalty if cancellation is made between 29 and 15 days before the passengers' arrival
- 55% penalty if cancellation is made between 14 and 10 days before the passengers' arrival
- 75% penalty if cancellation is made between 9 and 5 days before the passengers' arrival
- 85% penalty if cancellation is made between 4 and 2 days before the passengers' arrival

- No refund if cancellation is made less than 2 days before the passengers' arrival
- 100% penalty of the total amount for no-show
