RIO DE JANEIRO

Rio de Janeiro is usually referred as the marvelous city. Locked between sea and mountains covered by exuberant vegetations, this city surprises with its many incredible sceneries, its cultural diversity and the lively, festive, spirit from cariocas - the carnival is an emblematic representation of this.

It is one of the country's main economic, cultural, and financial centers, and is internationally renowned for its cultural icons, such as the statue of Christ the Redeemer (one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World).



















PETRÓPOLIS

Located 68 km from the city of Rio de Janeiro, Petrópolis is known as the "imperial city" of Brazil. Nestled in the mountains of the Serra dos Órgãos, in the valley of the Ouitandinha and Piabanha rivers, Petrópolis is a popular vacation destination in Brazil. In addition to the beauty of the surroundings, the main attraction is the summer palace of the former Brazilian imperial family, which now houses the Brazilian Imperial Museum, specializing in imperial history.



















TIRADENTES

Surrounded by the São José Mountain range, Tiradentes is known for its historical and cultural heritage. The town's name comes from the hero of the Inconfidência Mineira, the first political movement for Brazil's independence. Its well-preserved architecture is of the purest colonial baroque style, visible in its houses, facades, churches, and fountains. Comfort, sophistication, and style make Tiradentes one of the most charming cities in Minas Gerais.



OURO PRETO

Founded at the end of the 17th century, Ouro Preto, also known as Black Gold, was the cradle of the gold rush and the epicenter of Brazil's golden age in the 18th century. Despite the economic decline in the 19th century due to the depletion of gold resources, the city never lost the splendor of its prosperous past. Its majestic churches, elegant bridges, and ornate fountains remain exceptional examples of colonial baroque. Ouro Preto holds the privilege of being the first Brazilian site to be inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage list, highlighting its historical and architectural significance and preserving its legacy for future generations.








INHOTIM

Inhotim is the largest outdoor museum in the world, located in the city of Brumadinho, in the state of Minas Gerais. Combining contemporary art and nature, this space offers a unique experience for visitors, who can explore sculptures and installations amidst botanical gardens. Tourism at Inhotim is fascinating, providing an ecological immersion with trails to explore, rare plants to discover, and the opportunity to admire works by renowned artists in a sustainable environment in harmony with nature.



SALVADOR DE BAHIA

Salvador de Bahia was the first capital of Brazil and a convergence point for European, African, and Indigenous cultures. Founded in 1549, the colony developed due to sugarcane cultivation. The need for labor and its proximity to the African coast made it a hub for the slave trade. The majority of the population has African ancestry, earning it the nickname "Black Rome," characterized by vibrant African culture (spicy food and voodoo rites), dances (axé and samba), and a colorful carnival.



VISIT OF THE CORCOVADO

Duration: 4 hours



Corcovado is a 710-meter-high granite peak located in the Tijuca Forest, offering a privileged view of the city of Rio de Janeiro and Guanabara Bay. It is famous for being home to the Christ the Redeemer statue, one of the main symbols of the city and the country. The Corcovado railway line, starting from the Cosme Velho station, was inaugurated in 1884. With a length of 3,824 meters, it was the country's first railway built exclusively for tourist purposes. The train, older than the statue itself, transported the necessary pieces for its construction during the four years of work. In 1910, this railway line became the first in Brazil to be electrified, and the old steam trains were replaced by electric machines.

ASCENSION OF THE SUGAR LOAF

Duration: 4 hours



The ascension of the Sugarloaf Mountain is done by cable car in two stages: the first journey takes you to Mount Urca, where you can already enjoy a breathtaking view of the city. On the second cable car, you'll arrive at the summit of Sugarloaf. This name evokes the refined sugar blocks placed in clay molds for transport by boat during the sugarcane trade era. However, it's possible that this explanation is just a popular etymology, and the name may actually derive from the Tupi-Guarani language, "Paunh-acuqua," which means "great hill" in English. This peak, a monolithic granite block, is the only one among all the city's peaks to rise directly from the seaside. It is located on a peninsula at the entrance to Guanabara Bay.




VISITE OF THE BOTANIC GARDEN

Duration: 4 hours

Considered one of the world's best tropical botanical gardens, this peaceful haven is home to rare specimens of Brazilian flora as well as plants from other countries. It is also a highly regarded spot for numerous species of tropical birds. Established in 1808, it covers an area of 137 hectares. The garden is divided into several sections (Japanese, sensory, tropical, cactus). Listen closely! If you hear branches cracking, it's because monkeys are overhead.


VISIT OF THE HISTORIC CENTER

Duration: 4 hours



The center of Rio, despite some residential buildings, is primarily a commercial and tourist district, housing the largest concentration of financial institutions. Historic buildings share this space with modern skyscrapers. In addition to its numerous churches, this neighborhood boasts a rich historical heritage representing colonial, imperial, republican, as well as contemporary eras, such as the Capanema building designed by Le Corbusier, Niemeyer, and Lucio Costa. It truly feels like traversing through time!

VISIT OF THE BABILONIA-CHAPÉU-MANGUEIRA COMMUNITY

Duration: 4 hours



Located on a hillside, this favela is situated in the Copacabana neighborhood and was the opening scene of Marcel Camus' film "Black Orpheus." It is a small community with 3,000 residents. You will stroll through the winding alleyways of the favela and have the opportunity to admire Copacabana Beach, Sugarloaf Mountain, and Corcovado from different angles. It was pacified in 2009, meaning it is no longer under the control of traffickers. To access the community (located on a hillside), clients will use mototaxis that the community residents themselves use (ride time: 2 minutes)

VISIT TO THE CITY OF PETRÓPOLIS



Petrópolis, known as the "Imperial City" of Brazil, is a Brazilian city located in the center of Rio de Janeiro. It is 68 km from the city of Rio de Janeiro. The city is named "City of Stone" in honor of Emperor Pedro II, the second monarch of the nation and son of Pedro I of Brazil. It served as the summer residence of the Empire and aristocrats in the 19th century and was the official capital of the State of Rio de Janeiro between 1894 and 1902.

DISCOVER SÃO JOÃO DEL REI



Discovering São João del Rei is a plus. Here, colonial-era religious traditions are still very much alive in its churches, processions, and the faith of its inhabitants. São João is unique in that it has managed to preserve a colonial village surrounded by a vibrant commercial hub, making it possible to appreciate the urban evolution of a wonderfully preserved colonial city in harmony with the eclectic architecture of the 19th and 20th centuries.

WALKING TOUR OF OURO PRETO



Immerse yourself in history with a walk to explore the city's key landmarks, such as the Church of Saint Francis of Assisi, built by the famous Aleijadinho, the Church of Nossa Senhora do Pilar, the Museum of Mines, the Museum of Oratory, and the Opera House. End the experience with a regional lunch to taste "Feijão Tropeiro" and "Tutu à Mineira."

VISIT TO MARIANA AND EXPLORATION OF AN OLD GOLD MINE



A descent into an old gold mine will complete your visit to this region. The richness of this past wasn't baroque for everyone. Today, this recreational site is highly appreciated by curious visitors. The old, rustic wagons used to descend into the mine galleries promise a thrilling experience!

OURO PRETO **SUGGESTION**



DISCOVERY OF INHOTIM



This institution is both a major contemporary art center and a botanical garden, combining the beauty of nature with that of art, as well as serving as a research center. The institute is said to have the largest collection of contemporary art in the world and the largest open-air museum in the world. Designed by the renowned Brazilian landscaper Roberto Burle Marx, the botanical garden spans 1,200 hectares (with one hundred hectares open to the public), featuring artificial lakes and various animal species. It houses the planet's largest collection of palms (1,500 varieties), as well as thousands of orchids, bromeliads, cacti, and giant water lilies (over 4,300 recorded tropical plants).

VISIT THE LOWER CITY

Duration: 4 hours



The Church of Nosso Senhor do Bonfim, where the famous Bonfim ribbons are distributed, is one of the most traditional churches, dedicated to Senhor do Bonfim, the patron saint of Bahia and a symbol of religious syncretism in Bahia. Every year, the Bonfim Church Staircase Washing event turns into a grand celebration. It starts with a procession from the Church of Our Lady of Conception of the Beach, patroness of Bahia, to Bonfim. A large crowd joins in the festivities. Visit Mercado Modelo, inaugurated on December 9, 1912, which originally offered a wide range of fruits, vegetables, meats, flours, etc. Today, it is the largest craft market in Brazil's Northeast.

SALVADOR OPTIONS



STROLL THROUGH THE HISTORIC CENTER: PELOURINHO

Duration: 4 hours



The Pelourinho neighborhood, located in the historic center (upper town), features a baroque colonial architectural ensemble classified by UNESCO as a cultural heritage site. Warmly called "Pelô" by its residents, this neighborhood was primarily residential and home to the most beautiful mansions until the early 20th century. Besides its historical aspect, it is also a vibrant cultural hub of Bahia. The tour includes a visit to the Church and Convent of São Francisco, built in the 17th and 18th centuries, and considered one of the most unique and rich expressions of Brazilian baroque.

SALVADOR BY NIGHT: MIGUEL SANTANA SHOW & DINNER





Located in Pelourinho, the Miguel Santana Folkloric Theater opened its doors in 1988 and is now considered the only dance company dedicated to folklore in Brazil. Several times, this troupe of dancers has won internationally renowned awards. After the show, dinner will take place at a local restaurant in the historic center. The folkloric ballet is open on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

EXTENSION OPTION PRAIA DO FORTE

Praia do Forte, an old fishing village 80 km from Salvador, is home to Projeto Tamar (a Brazilian sea turtle conservation project). Its streets along the beach, its baroque church, and the ruins of its 16th-century castle are all places to explore. Swimming is inviting on its 12 km of semi-deserted beach lined with dunes, coconut trees, and natural pools.



EXTENSION OPTION MORRO DE SÃO PAULO

Morro de São Paulo is a charming village located on Tinharé Island, the largest in the archipelago. Colonized by the Portuguese in the 17th century, the island is home to a fort built to defend the entrance to the city of Salvador. Accessible only by plane or boat, Morro de São Paulo is a true haven of peace, free from vehicles. Its paradisiacal landscapes and beaches, enlivened by the joy of its residents, make it an ideal place for those seeking rest and relaxation, while also offering the chance to enjoy a lively nightlife.

CANCELLATION
