SALVADOR

Salvador is also known as Brazil's capital of happiness due to its countless popular outdoor parties, including its street carnival. The first colonial capital of Brazil, the city is one of the oldest in the Americas. The African influence in many cultural aspects of the city makes it the center of Afro-Brazilian culture. The historical center of Salvador, frequently called Pelourinho, is renowned for its Portuguese colonial architecture with historical monuments dating from the 17th to the 19th centuries and was declared a Worlds Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1985.

















MORRO DE SÃO PAULO

Morro de São Paulo is a village located on Tinharé Island, the largest in the archipelago. It was colonized by the Portuguese in the 17th century, where a fort was built to defend the entrance to the city of Salvador. Vehicle-free, Morro de São Paulo can only be reached by plane or boat. With its paradisiacal landscapes and beaches, and a vibrant atmosphere, it is an ideal destination for those seeking rest, relaxation, and the chance to enjoy a lively nightlife

VISIT TO THE LOWER CITY

Duration: 6 hours



The Nosso Senhor do Bonfim Church, where the famous Bonfim ribbons are distributed, is one of the most traditional churches dedicated to the patron saint of Bahians and symbol of the religious syncretism of the state. Each year, the washing of the stairs of the Church of Bonfim, gives rise to a great celebration. This experience takes you to pay a visit to the Mercado Modelo, inaugurated on December 9, 1912, which at the time offered a wide choice of fruits, vegetables, meats, flour, etc. Today it is the largest artisanal market in northeastern Brazil.

SALVADOR BY NIGHT: MIGUEL SANTANA'S FOLKLORIC BALLET

Located in Pelourinho, the Miguel Santana folk theater opened in 1988 and is considered the only dance company dedicated to folklore in Brazil. On several occasions, this troupe of dancers has won internationally renowned prizes. After the show, dine at a local restaurant in the historic center.

Percussion Class

Duration: 01 hours

A percussion course offers an immersion in Brazilian musical culture. Students learn the rhythms of samba-reggae and capoeira. Supervised by local musicians, they discover traditional techniques and the history of the instruments. It is an enriching experience that combines learning and practice



CAPOEIRA CLASS

Duration: 01 hours

Capoeira is an Afro-Brazilian martial art that is believed to have its roots in the combat techniques and dances of African peoples during the time of slavery in Brazil. It distinguishes itself from other martial arts through its playful and often acrobatic nature. The feet are widely used during combat, although other parts of the body can be employed, such as the hands, head, knees, and elbows. The "players" can support or balance themselves on their hands to perform kicks or acrobatics. In various forms, capoeira is played and/or fought at different levels on the ground and at different speeds, usually accompanied by instruments, songs, and clapping.

- Date of Birth.
- Passport N° with which each passenger will enter the country as well as its expiration date,
- Nationality,
- Exact information about their international flights to and from the country (numbers, time and company), their e-ticket number (this last information may be sent afterwards) as well as the same information on domestic flights, if applicable.

Brazil Sensations will reserve, according to the services agreed on common understanding, all the necessary initial reservations and will send a balance sheet in the form of a confirmation letter (OK = confirmed; WL = Wating List; RQ = Waiting for and Answer).

- Once we receive your confirmation, we send you a prepay invoice corresponding the requirements of certain suppliers to guarantee the reservation. (Around 20 %)
- This invoice should be paid when it is received in order to guarantee the reservations of your program
- The final invoice should be paid 30 days before the arrival date of the passengers. We reserve the right to cancel or alter provision of the services if the invoice is not paid before the arrival date of the group to the destination; in such case, we cannot be held accountable and such actions won't justify future complaints or indemnity.

CANCELLATION

All cancellation will be received in writing only and according to the following terms:

LAND SERVICES

- If the cancellation is made 30 days prior to the arrival date, we charge USD \$
 50 per pax
- Between the 29tth and 15th day prior to the arrival date, we charge 20%
- Between the 14th and 10th day prior to the arrival date, we charge 55%
- Between the 9th and 5th day prior to the arrival date, we charge 75%
- Between the 4th and 2nd day prior to the arrival date, we charge 85%
- No refund if cancellation is made as for the 4th day prior to the arrival date.
- In case of no show the 100% of full amount of the services will be charged.

Christmas, New Year's Eve and Carnival packages are non-refundable.

SPECIAL TERMS
