




PARATY


VISIT TO THE CORCOVADO

Duration: 4 hours



The Corcovado is a granite peak 710 meters high, located in the Tijuca Forest, offering a privileged view of the city of Rio de Janeiro and Guanabara Bay. It is famous for hosting at its summit the Christ the Redeemer statue, one of the main symbols of the city and the country. The Corcovado railway, departing from the Cosme Velho station, was inaugurated in 1884. Stretching 3,824 meters, it is the first in the country built exclusively for tourism purposes. The train, older than the statue itself, transported the necessary parts for its construction during the four years of work. In 1910, this line was the first in Brazil to be electrified, and the old steam trains were replaced by electric engines.

ASCENT OF SUGARLOAF MOUNTAIN

Duration: 4 hours



The ascent of Sugarloaf Mountain is done by cable car in two stages: the first trip takes you to the top of Urca Hill, where you can already enjoy a breathtaking view of the city. On the second cable car, you will reach the summit of Sugarloaf Mountain. This name evokes the blocks of refined sugar placed in clay molds for transport by boat during the sugar cane trade era. However, it is possible that this explanation is merely popular etymology, and the name might derive from the Tupi-Guarani word Pau-nh-acuqua ("big hill" in French). This peak, a monolithic granite block, is unique among the city's peaks as it rises directly from the sea. It is located on a peninsula at the entrance to Guanabara Bay.

SAMBA CLASS AT THE GRAND CARLINHOS DE JESUS SCHOOL

Regarded as the greatest and most renowned Samba dancer, Carlinhos de Jesus is a Brazilian legend. Having traversed eras and generations, he is an expert in Samba and the world of Carnival. He established a school in the Botafogo neighborhood where his carefully selected troupe offers Samba and percussion lessons.



VISIT OF THE FOOTBALL TEMPLE, THE MARACANÃ

Duration: 4 hours

A temple of football, the stadium was built for the FIFA World Cup Brazil 1950 and was immortalized by one of the most memorable moments in World Cup history—the unforgettable final between Brazil and Uruguay. For the 2014 FIFA World Cup, the Maracanã was renovated. Once known as "the largest stadium in the world," hosting over 200,000 spectators at times, it has since reduced its capacity to 73,531 spectators.



ART TOUR: HEART OF CREATION

Duration: 6 hours



Discover art in all its forms with this 6-hour tour in Rio de Janeiro. Start with an immersive visit to Fábrica Bhering, a former industrial complex turned into artist studios. Then, dive into the vibrant world of street art with a guided tour of the city's most iconic graffiti. Finally, end your adventure at a contemporary art gallery in Ipanema, where you'll explore an exhibition featuring a Brazilian artist alongside works by some of Brazil's and the world's greatest artists. An unforgettable artistic journey in the heart of Rio!



VISIT TO THE BOTANICAL GARDEN

Duration: 4 hours



Considered one of the best tropical botanical gardens in the world, this peaceful haven houses rare specimens of Brazilian and other international flora. It is also a favorite spot for many species of tropical birds.

Established in 1808, it spans 137 hectares. The garden is divided into several sections (Japanese, sensory, tropical, cactus). Listen closely! If you hear branches cracking, it means the monkeys are above your head.



TREKKING IN TIJUCA FOREST

Duration: 4 hours



The Tijuca Forest is a reforested mountainous region located in the city of Rio de Janeiro. It is considered the largest urban forest in the world, covering an area of 32 km². Your French-speaking guide will pick you up from the hotel at 8:00 AM. Private transport (about 30 minutes) to the Tijuca Forest. Stops at viewpoints at Mesa do Imperador and Vista Chinesa, then at the Taunay Waterfall. Enter the park through the visitor center and then transport to the start of the hike. Hike to Pico da Tijuca, approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes round trip (medium difficulty).



VISIT TO THE SANTA TERESA NEIGHBORHOOD

Duration: 4 hours



The Santa Teresa neighborhood was built around the convent of the same name in the 18th century. It was once inhabited by the bourgeoisie of the time and was one of the first expansions of the city. Houses inspired by French architecture were constructed there, some of which still remain. In 1872, the "bonde" (tram) arrived, becoming the symbol of the neighborhood. Since 1896, the bonde has provided access to downtown, crossing over the Lapa Arches, a former disused aqueduct.



NIGHT AT RIO SCENARIUM

Duration: 5 hours

In the heart of Rio, Rio Scenarium is located in the vibrant Lapa neighborhood. Like an antique shop, it enchants with its unique and singular originality. With multiple floors and diverse atmospheres, the musical ambiance is quite varied: samba, MPB (Brazilian Popular Music), bossa nova, and jazz. Rio Scenarium is a classic spot in Carioca nightlife!

Please note that from Sunday to Tuesday, this establishment is closed.


VISIT THE HISTORIC CITY CENTER

Duration: 4 hours

Tour to avoid on Sundays.



The center of Rio, despite some residential buildings, is primarily a commercial and tourist district, housing the largest concentration of financial institutions. Historical buildings share this space with modern skyscrapers. In addition to its countless churches, this area boasts a rich historical heritage spanning the colonial, imperial, republican, and contemporary eras, such as the Capanema Building designed by Le Corbusier, Niemeyer, and Lucio Costa. It truly offers a sensation of traveling through time!



VISIT TO THE BABILONIA- CHAPEU MANGUEIRA COMMUNITY

Duration: 4 hours



Situated on a hillside, this favela is located in the Copacabana neighborhood and was the opening scene of the film *Orfeu Negro* by Marcel Camus. It is a small community with 3,000 inhabitants. You will stroll through the winding alleys of the favela and have the chance to admire views of Copacabana Beach, Sugarloaf Mountain, and the Christ the Redeemer statue from different angles. It was pacified in 2009, meaning it is no longer under the control of traffickers. To reach the community (situated on a hillside), visitors will use moto-taxis, which are commonly used by the residents themselves (travel time: 2 minutes).

TREKKING TO THE WATERFALL: FEITICEIRA

Duration: 5 hours



The hike to Cachoeira da Feiticeira on Ilha Grande is a magnificent and rewarding experience for nature lovers. The trail takes you through a lush tropical forest, offering a glimpse of the island's rich biodiversity along the way.

Starting from Vila do Abraão, the main village on Ilha Grande, the trailhead is easily accessible. It usually takes about 40 to 60 minutes to reach the waterfall, depending on your pace and any stops you make along the way.

As you progress deeper into the forest, you'll encounter a variety of native plants and wildlife, including colorful birds and exotic butterflies. The trail is well-marked and relatively easy, though it can be a bit muddy in some sections, so wearing appropriate footwear is recommended.

Upon reaching Cachoeira da Feiticeira, you'll be greeted by the sight and sound of a stunning waterfall cascading into a refreshing natural pool. It's the perfect spot to cool off after your hike and enjoy the tranquil surroundings. Some visitors even enjoy a swim in the pool beneath the waterfall.

Be sure to bring plenty of water, insect repellent, and sunscreen for your hike, and please respect the environment by leaving no waste behind. Enjoy your adventure to Cachoeira da Feiticeira and the natural beauty of Ilha Grande!

VISIT TO LAGOA AZUL (BLUE LAGOON)



The most traditional tour of Ilha Grande begins at the Vila Abraão pier and takes you to the Blue Lagoon, a cove with calm, transparent waters perfect for snorkeling. Here, you can swim among colorful fish and observe the local marine life.

After visiting the Blue Lagoon, you'll head to the parish village of Santana and its beautiful beach. From there, you'll proceed to Japariz Beach for an optional lunch.

Included: Regular, non-private service on a regional schooner, transportation, seasonal fruits, and floatation devices.




WALK TOUR AROUND THE HISTORIC CITY CENTER OF PARATY

Duration: 2 hours

The tour of the historic center is conducted on foot only. The town was founded in 1667, centered around the Church of Nossa Senhora dos Remédios. The construction of houses and churches reflects the architectural style of that era. The presence of water, with the tide's invasion during the full moon, the cultivation of coffee and sugar cane, the port, and Freemasonry are elements that shaped the layout of Paraty's historic center.

Today, the historic center is considered "the most harmonious colonial architectural ensemble" (UNESCO) and has been a UNESCO World Heritage site since 2019. The streets, protected by chains to prevent vehicle traffic, still retain their colonial charm, combined with a diverse range of shops and vibrant cultural and artistic expressions.

PARATY OPTIONS



DISCOVER THE SERRA BOCAINA WITH JEEP

Duration: 6 hours

Explore the Serra Bocaina, a conservation area of the Atlantic Forest, by jeep. This tour offers the opportunity to immerse yourself in the lush nature, admire waterfalls, and discover the Gold Trail, an old colonial route that connected Paraty to Minas Gerais, the gold mining region. The tour includes a visit to a distillery to learn about the process of making cachaça, with a tasting included during the visit.



CRUZ IN THE BAY OF PARATY

Duration: 5 hours

The Bay of Paraty boasts 65 islands and hundreds of beaches with turquoise waters. During this cruise on a traditional schooner, you'll have the opportunity to make several swimming stops, allowing you to better explore this little paradise.

OPTIONS

DISCOVER THE REGION BY SPEEDBOAT



Duration: 5 hours

Explore the region from the water with an exhilarating speedboat tour. This high-speed adventure allows you to cover more ground and see the stunning coastline, hidden coves, and picturesque islands from a unique vantage point. Enjoy the thrill of the ride as you discover the natural beauty and charm of the area, making stops at scenic spots along the way.



DISCOVER THE REGION OF MAMANGUA WITH CANOE *Duration: 7 hours*



Welcome by your guide at the pousada. Departure by private car to Paraty Mirim, where you will take a boat to the Mamanguá region. From there, continue by canoe through rivers and mangroves, surrounded by the Atlantic Forest, to a natural pool with crystal-clear waters. Enjoy a swim before returning by canoe. Optional lunch in a local community. Return to Paraty Mirim by motorboat and then by car to the pousada.




TREKKING TO THE "PÃO DE AÇUCAR" - SACO DO MAMANGUÁ

Duration: 5 hours

Discover the beauty of the Saco do Mamanguá bay after a hike in Brazil's only fjord. Depart from the pousada towards the port of Paraty Mirim, then continue by motorboat (40 min) to Praia do Cruseiro. This is where the intermediate-level hike begins, lasting 1.5 hours. After taking in the view, you will descend back to the beach for a swim and a lunch at a local restaurant (not included).

Please note: This restaurant does not accept credit cards.



TREKKING TO YHE WATERFALL: MELANCIA

Duration: 7 hours



The hike to Melancia Waterfall in Paraty is an unforgettable adventure into nature. The trail begins through a dense forest where you can admire the region's rich biodiversity, including an impressive variety of plants and animals. The route is marked by crystal-clear streams and small waterfalls, offering refreshing stops along the way.

Upon arrival, the majestic Melancia Waterfall reveals itself in all its splendor. Water cascades over the rocks, forming a natural pool where hikers can swim and cool off. The tranquility and beauty of this place make it a perfect spot to relax and enjoy nature after the hike.

This trek is ideal for nature lovers and adventurers seeking an authentic experience in one of Paraty's most beautiful areas.
